- Drexel University (Philadelphia) was ranked #86 among national universities and the #2 Most "Up-and-Coming" national university. Drexel has a highly ranked co-op program, allowing students to earn money and work experience in university.
- **Penn State University**, University Park, is ranked **#47 among national universities**. PSU has more than 20 campuses in Pennsylvania, including its Brandywine campus, 15 minutes from Delaware County Community College.
- > **St. Joseph's University** (Philadelphia) is ranked the **#13 Regional University** (North) in the nation. A Jesuit institution, St. Joe's has a great reputation and is the smallest of the institutions mentioned here.
- Temple University (Philadelphia) has the #9 ranked International Business Program in the nation, tied with U.C. Berkeley. Temple has campuses in Tokyo and Rome, and its Tyler School of Art is highly ranked among the nation's art programs.
- Villanova University is ranked the #1 Regional University (North) in the nation.
